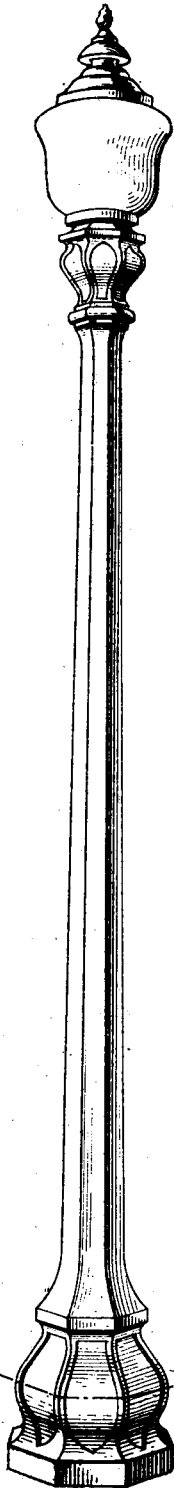

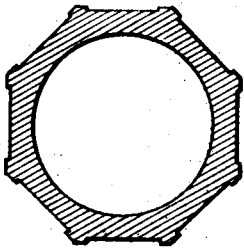

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, FAYETTE DRAPER BULLA, a citizen of the United States, residing at South Bend, in the county of St. Joseph and State of Indiana, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lighting-Post, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof.
